

Two Clarkson University Honors students from the Mechanical and Aeronautical Engineering Department have been named Goldwater Scholars by the Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship and Excellence in Education Foundation.

Juniors Ryan T. Watkins and Sayuri Yapa have both been awarded Goldwater Scholarships. Ryan is majoring in aeronautical engineering and Sayuri is majoring in mechanical engineering.

Only 52 of this year's 321 scholarships were awarded to engineers. The scholars were selected on the basis of academic merit from a field of 1,035 mathematics, science, and engineering students who were nominated by the faculties of colleges and universities nationwide.

Including Ryan and Sayuri, 19 Clarkson students have received this highly coveted award since the Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship and Excellence in Education Foundation was established in 1986.
